In addition, he received a Full Blue in 1957 and a Half Blue in 1958 for rowing at the University of Melbourne.

Phillip will also be recognised as Scotch College's seventh Principal (1975-1982) and was noted as a progressive school leader, best remembered for putting the interests and welfare of his school students first.
