HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP POLICY

The responsibility for recommending Honorary Life Memberships is delegated to the Life Membership Naming Sub-Committee of the MUBC Committee.

Responsibilities of the Honorary Life Membership Naming Sub-Committee (HLMSC):

- Considering those suitable for nomination on a semi-annual basis at least;
- Considering nominations from other Committee members and other current full club members;
- Maintaining the Honorary Life Membership register as a live and historical document;
- Ensuring life memberships are named on the Honorary Life Membership Honour Board in a timely manner;
- Reporting to the Committee and other committees as necessary.

The guiding principles the HLMSC will consider for awarding Honorary Life Memberships are as follows:

Exemplary and extraordinary service to MUBC.

Resolutions & final recommendations

Through resolution either at MUBC Committee meetings or through Circulatory Resolution between meetings, the MUBC Committee shall vote to ratify and endorse the HLMSC's recommendations.

Honorary Life Member Awards

The awarding of an Honorary Life Membership shall be announced and celebrated at a suitable time and be recorded at the next Annual General Meeting.

Life Member Register – Honorary and other

The Life Membership Register will list the names of Life Members and Honorary Life Members. The electronic copy of the register is to be kept on the MUBC database.

Life members that are not categorised as Honorary Life Members will be recorded on the register as Life Members.
